Welcome! We are so glad you are registered for the Annual Church Music Workshop! Our team has planned a wonderful week filled with opportunities to fellowship, make music, and learn together.

Registration at the Warren Willis Conference Center (4991 Picciola Rd., Fruitland Park) begins at 2:30pm, on Monday, June 14th. Please follow the registration signs, park near the Auditorium, and proceed to the Auditorium Lobby to pick up your notebook and room key (if you are staying on campus). All attendees must undergo a COVID health screening outside of the auditorium. There will be a station for high school girls, high school boys, middle schoolers, and adults. If you are a part of a group, please send one or two people from your group to pick up your group's notebooks & room keys. Room check-in will begin at 3:00pm. If you are a commuter, please check in at 4:15pm in the Auditorium Lobby before our first session. At 4:30pm, we will all assemble in the Auditorium for our Opening Worship Gathering followed by Orientation for both youth and adults. After dinner in the dining hall at 5:30pm, we will come back together for our first intergenerational choral rehearsal in the auditorium led by James Wells, our Choral Clinician. Following our rehearsal time, adults are invited to the President's Welcome Reception in Pearson. Please remember that masks are required when we are inside a room or building. ***Please be aware that Warren Willis Youth Campers will also be arriving at the same time and traffic may be heavier than usual. Make sure that you make a right turn off of Picciola Road to enter the Conference Center site.***

Information for Friday, June 18th

The last day of our Workshop will be different than usual. This year we will **not** be presenting a Final Celebration Concert. Instead, we will be recording all of the groups that usually participate in our final concert -- Advanced & Intermediate Handbells, Instrumental Ensemble, and our Intergenerational Choir.

- Recording Schedule: 9am Advanced Handbells, 9:30am Instrumental Ensemble, 10am Intermediate Handbells, and 10:30am Intergenerational Choir
- Dress for Recording Session: Primary color shirts or blouse (or white shirt & tie for men) and dark or black pants/skirt (ladies).
- Only those participating in each recording session will be allowed into the Auditorium during the recording.
- Recordings will be available on our website sometime during the week following Workshop. You will receive an e-mail with a link to the recordings.

Per our Safety Protocols, we will not be allowing the public into the Auditorium during our recording sessions or any of our sessions during the week. At 11am, we will finish our recording session and will celebrate our week with a special send off outside the auditorium. Our final meal will be breakfast on Friday, June 14th. Please plan on lunch on your way out of town.
