

## **Rules for Middle School and High School Students**

- 1 – If you take special medications, please advise Anne, Ms. Stephany, and your chaperone!
- 2 – Boys are NOT allowed in the girl's dorm areas and girls are NOT allowed in the boy's dorm areas—at ANY time. Housing for Middle School and High School will be separate. Do not climb on the ledges of the building. This is for your own safety.
- 3 – As this is a church music camp, please dress appropriately for all occasions. Girls bring clothes that will not expose midriff or cleavage. Guys, please wear a belt or pants that fit. Be advised that caps will be removed in morning Chapel and choir rehearsals. Girls, please no bare shoulders during worship-bring a cardigan if you are wearing a tank-top for the day. Inappropriate comments, language or discussions will not be tolerated.
- 4 – The Workshop is designed to help you learn a great deal in a short amount of time. For this reason, all participants must attend ALL scheduled activities and arrive at the announced time, unless prior approval has been granted.
- 5 – All participants are expected and required to stay on property for the entire Workshop. Failure to do so will result in immediate dismissal from workshop.
- 6 – There is to be no smoking, tobacco, or the use of alcohol, drugs or any other controlled substance while at Workshop.
- 7 – You must wear your name tag at all times when moving around the Warren Willis Conference Center Campus. This identifies you as a participant with our group. It is also your responsibility to keep track of your room key.
- 8 – Middle schoolers must be accompanied by a member of Youth Team or a chaperone when moving around campus. High schoolers must be in a group with at least 2 other high schoolers when moving around campus.
- 9 – Do NOT change dorm room assignments without approval from Ms. Stephany. In an emergency situation, we need to know where everyone is located.
- 10 – There is to be NO leaving your assigned dorm room after the 11:00PM curfew, which will be strictly enforced. Leaving your room at night can result in you being reassigned immediately to a staff member's room for the week or being sent home immediately. (Please see explanation below.)
- 11 – Follow any instructions and rules, given to you by a Youth Team member or Dean.
- 12 – Electronic devices should only be in use during approved times which will be discussed when you arrive at camp which include, but not limited to free time, meals, class changes. Use of electronic devices during classes, worship, and rehearsal will not be accepted.

**Breaking these rules could result in your being sent home from the workshop.**

\*\*\* Please familiarize yourself with our expectations for YOU this week. We will be strictly enforcing the housing rules due to the safety concern for our campers. Each night a staff member will go to each dorm to make sure the correct campers are in the correct rooms. Once the room is approved, the campers will be secured into that room until the next morning. We will be using duct tape on each door which allows us to see which student has opened their door while still allowing them to open the door in case of an emergency. If a student has an emergency and needs to leave their room, they need to report to: Anne, Stephany, or Bryan immediately. Any camper who is caught outside of their dorm will be sent home the next morning. There are no exceptions to this. Because of the layout of the campus we will have a “no grace policy” for anyone who is caught breaking the housing rules. We want everyone to have an amazing week at camp and be safe at the same time. Please do not put yourself or a dean in the position to have to send you home early.
