PLEASE BRING

- o Appropriate Daily Attire for a Church Activity
 - Girls: No exposed midriff or cleavage, no camisoles, no spaghetti straps, no tube tops, no short shorts, shoulders must be covered during worship if wearing a tank top

Courses:

Each youth workshop notebook will contain a list of course descriptions and a course sign-up form. We will sign-up for classes together during orientation. At orientation, you will have the opportunity to meet your teachers and hear more about each class. You will rank your top choices for each of the 3 sessions. Please keep in mind that some classes have an age restriction, some classes have limited enrollment, and some classes are intergenerational (adults and youth). We try our best to assign every camper the courses of their choice.

For classes with limited enrollment, priority is given to campers who are seniors and campers who have been attending for the most years.

It is recommended that you bring the suggested materials (if possible) for your top 3 choices in each session just in case you do not get your 1st choice of class.
